

to beating the thieves

1. Take practical steps

Make sure that your vehicle is fully locked and secured to help protect your tools and deter any opportunists.





2. Mind where you park

Park in areas where your vehicle will be clearly visible to regular passers-by, so you can minimise the risk of theft or damage

3. Alarms, locks & trackers

A wide variety of sophisticated vehicle locks, alarms and trackers are available, which can add an additional layer to your vehicle security.





4. Physical deterrents

Security stickers and etching make re-selling stolen goods more problematic, and your tools become a less attractive target.

5. Van Insurance cover

You should always check with your insurer. Find out what cover is included, and if you have cover, what the limits and exclusions are.
