Once you have started to make your claim, you will not be able to save the information midway through and return to it. The portal will remain open for one hour. If the information is not submitted within this time it will be lost and you will need to start the process again.



## Things to remember when submitting your claim

- For any tools with an original purchase value of £1,000 or more, we may ask for proof of purchase. These documents can be uploaded to our online claims form when submitting your new claim. This will speed up the process.
- For any theft or malicious damage claim, we will require a crime reference number. Where there are visible signs of break in to your van or car, please also provide a photo showing the damage and upload this through our online claims form. If you cannot provide a photo, please let us know why this is unavailable.
- When we can offer a settlement on your claim, Zurich have an instant chat facility available. If you provide a mobile number as part of your contact information, you will receive a message from Zurich confirming the offer and requesting your BACS details so they can issue your payment.
